



## Students' Perceptions Related To The Interaction Between Teachers and Students in The Learning Process

Teachers are the main component in the learning process, teachers convey subject matter to students through interactions carried out in the teaching and learning process (Syafitri, R., 2017). Non-smooth interaction has an impact on the message conveyed by the teacher. The learning process must be based on the principle of optimal interaction between students and educators, students themselves, and students with various learning resources including the learning environment (Susilo, Agus & Isbandiyah, 2019).

So the interaction is said to be an educational interaction if it consciously has the aim of educating, leading students towards maturity, making it easier to communicate teaching and learning activities to students, so that students can carry out learning actions independently, making it easier for teachers to choose and compile teaching materials, helping make it easier for teachers to determine teaching and learning activities and learning media, making it easier for teachers to conduct learning (Darmiatus & Daryanto, 2013).

But to know that these interaction patterns each have disadvantages and advantages, one-way patterns where the interaction is only played by educators, while students are less involved (active teachers, passive students) then this interaction can be said to be less than ideal interaction (Park, S., 2020). While the two-way interaction pattern, the teacher plays a role and students also play a little role because students are given the opportunity to express their opinions, with this learning will start to be active. While the pattern of multi-directional interaction is a transaction that describes a lively and familiar atmosphere, fun and motivates students to be active and influence each other (Malloy, M., 2015).

The teaching situation or teaching and learning interaction process can occur in various patterns of interaction/communication above, but communication as a transaction is considered in accordance with the concept of active student learning as desired by experts in modern education (Farid, Faisol & Rahmat Aziz, 2023). In managing learning interactions, teachers must have the ability to design programs, master subject matter, be able to create conducive classroom conditions, be skilled in utilizing media and selecting sources, understand the methods used, have the skills to communicate programs and understand the foundations of education as a basis for action. Teaching emphasizes the interaction between teachers and students in the teaching and learning process (Abdullah B, 2017).

Classroom management is a set of teacher activities to develop good interpersonal relationships and a positive classroom emotional climate. This definition views classroom management as a process of creating a positive socio-emotional climate in the classroom. With this class management, the teacher will be easy to interact with because students have been arranged in such a way that is in accordance with the learning method. Managing the class will be a supporting factor if the teacher does it, if the teacher does not do class management, it will be an inhibiting factor in interaction (Delfi, I., & Hudaidah, H, 2021).

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The affectionate and conducive atmosphere that is successfully built in a relationship will enable a person to direct the interaction in a positive direction. This concept is very important and relevant not only to the concept of education today but also to education in the future (Sanjaya, W., 2012). Because affection provides reciprocity in the relationship between teachers and students. When a teacher, for example, does not love his student then how could he be able to direct and guide him. Therefore, love has an important role in education, and it can be categorized as the main role in education and in building harmonious relationships or interactions between teachers and students (Amadi, Aunur Shabur Maajid, 2022).

The teacher should also not let time pass without warning the student that the purpose of teaching is to get closer to Allah SWT. A teacher who is responsible for one subject should not belittle other subjects in front of his students (Kholillah, M., Furnamasari, Y., & Dewi, D., 2022).
